

FR. ARNOLD | PAROCHIAL VICAR

I always marveled every time I took a picture. No pictures are the same. I can always see differences when I examined the details of it. But most of all, I can see God's creation in my photos. When I read in the news about the solar eclipse, I noted down the date, the time, and exact place where the eclipse will be seen in totality. I make a plan to go the exact place and see the eclipse in its totality. April 8th is also my birthday! I knew that it would be a once in a life time experience and I promise to myself that I will take the best shot of that spectacular cosmological moment.

But God has a another plan for me. Instead of starting my day driving a long way to Indianapolis, I started it celebrating the Mass and thanking God for the gift of life that He has given me. 


