From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners.



Happy Sunday, friends. Here at St. Pat's, our community seeks to live out our faith through prayer, support of our parish ministries, and participation in the life of the parish, whether that be through attending Mass, assisting as a volunteer, or serving as a ministry leader. Though sometimes it may seem that we are in our own world here, we are part of a larger diocese community of more than 400,000 Catholics, spanning 11 counties, and 105 parishes in Illinois.

During the past year the Diocese of Rockford has ministered to people throughout the diocese, offering programs, service, and opportunities to our parish, our neighboring parishes, and to others living within the diocese. Thousands of people receive assistance from our diocese, and so too does our own parish. Diocesan ministries help with marriage preparation, faith formation, and charitable outreach, all funded through the Diocesan Appeal. The appeal also helps fund Catholic Charities, our Catholic schools, the formation of seminarians and deacons, and much more. By supporting the Diocesan Appeal, our parish unites with the rest of our diocesan community to provide these essential ministries and programs.

Next weekend every parish in our diocese will be asked to participate in the 2024 Diocesan Appeal. This campaign has an enormous impact on the ministries and programs that are offered at our parish and throughout the diocese.

This year's theme for the upcoming Diocesan Appeal is "Be Joyful Disciples." I invite you to take this idea to heart. The more we build a relationship with Christ in prayer, the more we can see His workings in our lives, and the more we can see Him in the faces of our brothers and sisters in Christ and be moved to act in compassion. It is during this busy time of year each year that we act together as a parish and help care for our neighbors in the Diocese of Rockford.

What we give in support to the Diocesan Appeal comes back to help us in many ways! Our goal this year for our parish is \$310,116. 


