Dear Parishioners,

Jesus wants us to give him our struggles so he can heal and strengthen us. Towards that end, the Sacrament of Confession is essential to our growing in the spiritual life.

We have many times for you to make your Lenten Confession. And Be Reconciled is coming on March 20. On this day all the priest of the diocese will be hearing Confessions from 9am till 8pm. Your priests at will be in the confessionals at Crane during that time.

1. Make sure you make a good examination of conscience so you know what to say.

2. Usually Confession is not a time for counseling, especially if there is a line.

3. Use the formula. Bless me Father...And how long it's been.

4. Give the priest a succinct list of your sins without embellishment, excuses or rationalizations. Just the sin and number of times if it's a mortal sin.

5. Let the priest know when your finished.


6. He'll give you a word or two, penance and then ask your to say the Act of Contrition.
